2023 was a down year for us in terms of giving from grants and large donor gifts.

We aim to increase our revenue to \$275,000 to support our staff (1 FT/11 PT) and operations.

One highlight in this area was the Young Commanders Dessert Fundraiser and 50/50 Club invitation, which brought in new donors while engaging past donors.



2030 TARGET

We will be active participants in the thriving of 10 virtuous communities across the country.

A virtuous community is defined as:

- A population between 10K-15K (*City, Community, or Cluster*)
- An established partnership with churches and/or Christian organization(s)
- Serving 5%-10% of students (*2-12 grade*) directly & indirectly and their families
- Certifying and providing continual education for 5%-10% of mentors



YEARLY CHALLENGE

BUILD TOWARDS THE TARGET

There are FOUR Criteria for an RLF Virtuous Community. We will make a minimum seven-year commitment to remain in the community that we agree to serve.

This year's challenge is to be meeting 2 out of the 4 criteria in FIVE communities.

IN 2024 WE WILL...

- Open a new chapter of Young Commanders in Opelika, Alabama, and Decatur, Georgia
- Certify 50 New Mentors
- Take 55-60 students to summer camp at Camp Grace
- Have 50 couples at the Mother & Son Ball
- Add 2 New Mentoring Programs to provide training through the YMC
- Recruit 7-8 new Board Members
